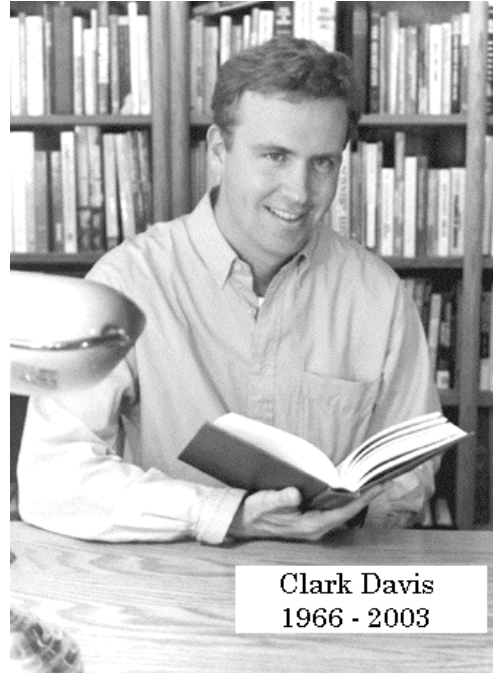


CLARK DAVIS ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

When the Loma Linda Academy Class of 1984 gathers for their 25th reunion in July 2009, they will be missing the significant presence of their senior class co-president and beloved friend, Clark Davis. Clark, who passed away suddenly and tragically in 2003, will always be remembered by his high school friends for his impish grin and deep chuckle, as well as his propensity for engaging in philosophical discussions until all hours of the morning. Most importantly, Clark's classmates, teachers, and the community members who knew him will remember the qualities of leadership and commitment to social justice that he carried with him into adulthood and that infused his career as a university professor. It is with the goal of preserving and passing along that legacy that the Class of 1984 is launching a campaign to raise funds for the Clark Davis Scholarship for Excellence in Leadership, a new scholarship endowment at Loma Linda Academy.



All contributions to the endowment fund will be tax deductible, and the total funds will be matched by the Southeastern California Conference once \$5000 is raised. The fundraising goal of \$42,000 will allow the Academy to award an annual scholarship of \$4,200 to a deserving student.
